The University of Faisalabad Collaborates with CI-UAF to Establish Confucius Institute Sub-Sets

The University of Faisalabad signed an agreement with the Confucius Institute at the University of Agriculture Faisalabad (CI-UAF) to set up a sub-campus focused on Chinese language education and cultural exchange. Prof Dr Aman Ullah Malik, Rector, TUF, signed the agreement on behalf of the University. Prof Dr Zulfiqar Ali, Vice Chancellor, UAF and Chairman of the CI-UAF Board of Directors, led the event. Prof Dr Abdul Wahid, Director Academics, was appointed as the focal person at The University of Faisalabad (TUF).

MoU with NetixSol to Strengthen Industry-Academia Linkages



International Symposium on Innovations in Amblyopia Care



The event brought together renowned experts, including Sameera Irfan, Pediatric Ophthalmologist, Oculoplastic & Neuro-Ophthalmologist, Pakistan, Dr Mei Ying Boon, Associate Professor and Program Leader, University of Canberra, Australia and Dr Yap Tiong Peng, FAAO, FACBO, FOVDR, Consultant Optometrist, Singapore.

The symposium highlighted innovations in amblyopia care and the importance of equitable access to pediatric eye health. Panel discussions explored practical solutions to healthcare disparities. Prof Dr Aamir Ali Chaudhary, Head, Department of Optometry & Ophthalmology, TUF, concluded the event, while Prof Dr Aman Ullah Malik, Rector, TUF, appreciated the department's efforts in hosting the symposium.

Mayo Clinic develops Al tool that can spot 9 dementia types with a single scan


Every three seconds, someone in the world develops dementia, according to Alzheimer's Disease International https://www.alzint.org/about/dementia-facts-

<u>figures/dementia-statistics/</u>. But misdiagnoses and slow diagnoses are common problems as other diseases can mimic dementia.

The researchers have developed an AI tool that could alter this landscape by identifying nine different types of dementia, including Alzheimer's disease, with 88% accuracy using just a single brain scan. The research, published in Neurology, details a new framework called StateViewer that draws on fluorodeoxyglucose PET (FDG-PET) imaging.
