Delegation from Palestine and Gaza Visits The University of Faisalabad

The visit represented a step toward strengthening academic and healthcare collaborations support Palestinian institutions and communities through education, research and medical assistance.

Mr Muhammad Haider Amin stated that TUF aims to support the people of Palestine by offering healthcare assistance through the advanced medical training and facilities available at University Medical & Dental College, Faisalabad and Madinah Teaching Hospital.

He announced that TUF would extend comprehensive assistance through research resources and a digital library, while also offering opportunities for **Palestinian** students, particularly those whose medical education has disrupted, to continue their studies at The University of Faisalabad. Currently, the University is hosting 19 Palestinian students enrolled in various disciplines, serving as beacon of hope and educational continuity for the youth of Gaza.

During the meeting, the Deans of TUF proposed practical solutions to extend academic and healthcare assistance to Gaza. They suggested online education initiating an support Palestinian program to students and establishing working coordination with in groups COMSTECH for prompt implementation.

The delegation also interacted with students and faculty members, sharing words of encouragement and appreciation for TUF's ongoing academic and humanitarian initiatives. The members of the delegation visited the state-of-theart Madinah Teaching Hospital and the advanced laboratories of the University.



Breakthrough in Blood-Based Diagnostics for Chronic Fatigue Syndrome



A recent study published in the Journal of Translational Medicine (2025) reports a major advancement in diagnosing Myalgic Encephalomyelitis/Chronic Fatigue Syndrome (ME/CFS). Researchers developed and validated a bloodbased diagnostic test using EpiSwitch® 3D genomic profiling, identifying a 200-marker model capable of distinguishing ME/CFS patients with 92% sensitivity and 98% specificity.
