Under this initiative, the university will establish an Incubation Unit to support entrepreneurial activities, while SBP will conduct training sessions for students. Additionally, a partner bank will provide financial assistance in the form of loans, including PKR 5 lac interest-free, up to PKR 15 lacs at 5% and up to PKR 7.5 million at 7%.



Decoding adipose-brain crosstalk: Distinct lipid cargo in human adiposederived extracellular vesicles modulates amyloid aggregation in Alzheimer's disease




Obesity is a risk factor for many diseases, from diabetes to heart disease to *Alzheimer's disease* (AD). A new study from <u>Houston Methodist</u> reports mechanistic evidence for a plausible fat-to-brain pathway. The study, published in <u>Alzheimer's & Dementia: The Journal of the Alzheimer's Association</u>, found that adipose-derived extracellular vesicles, cell-to-cell messengers, can accelerate *amyloid-\beta* aggregation in experimental models. Amyloid- β plaques are a hallmark of *AD*.


